

## **WellStar Student Requirement Summary – 2013/2014**

*Prerequisites must be completed before a badge can be obtained. Students are not allowed on WellStar campuses without a badge.*

*Students will submit documentation to their school or WellStar's Office of Student Affiliations. Contact Carol Westbrook 470-956-6448 with any questions.*

Health screening requirements:

- TB test(*classic tuberculin PPD, also known as purified protein derivative*)
    - Initially a 2-Step Skin Test, then an annual TB skin test. If a year is missed, the 2 Step is repeated.
    - If documentation of a previously positive skin test is provided, chest x-ray within the last six months with results within normal limits is required.
    - If the TB skin test is positive or chest x-ray abnormal, the student will not be allowed to begin their rotation.
  - Hepatitis B Vaccine Series, students must show proof of one of the below:
    - Documentation showing you have completed the vaccine series (if in process, at least the first 2 of 3 in the series for Hepatitis B).\
- OR**
- Documented Serology- Hep B Surface Antibody titer results indicate immunity to Hepatitis B.
  - Varicella Vaccination two doses, documented history of Chicken Pox disease or positive Varicella titer.
  - Documentation of Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis Vaccine-Tdap within the last 10 years (Td alone is not adequate).
  - Influenza Vaccine (Note; if you are unvaccinated, you will be required to wear a mask during peak influenza season when within 6 feet of a patient or when entering a patient's room.)
  - Measles, Mumps and Rubella Vaccine-MMR two doses

Additional requirements:

- Personal Health Insurance or signed Waiver
- Liability Insurance
- Professional License (if applicable)
- Current BLS Card with expiration date if certified
- Background Check and Drug Screening (Advantage Students, Inc. preferred) completed while in the current program of study.
- Respiratory Fit Testing (if required to enter Isolation Rooms)
- Confidentiality and Technology Agreement
- Graduate students:
  - Preceptor confirmation form signed by the WellStar preceptor
  - Letter of good standing from the school
  - Student Form
